I agree with the analysis of Mozilla in their "Petition to Recognize Remote Delivery Services in Terminating Access Networks and Classify Such Services as Telecommunications Services Under Title II of the Communications Act" (<https://blog.mozilla.org/netpolicy/files/2014/05/Mozilla-Petition.pdf>).

Your proposed path would open the door to widespread discrimination online. It would give Internet service providers the green light to implement pay-for-priority schemes that would be a disaster for startups, nonprofits and everyday Internet users who cannot afford these unnecessary tolls.

I urge you to scrap these other proposals and instead restore the principle of online nondiscrimination by reclassifying broadband as a telecommunications service.
