On May 5, 2014, Robert Irving on behalf of Laser, Inc. (“Laser”), and James Barker and the undersigned of Latham & Watkins LLP representing Laser, met with Gigi Sohn, Special Counsel to Chairman Wheeler; Renee Gregory, Legal Advisor to Chairman Wheeler; and Roger Sherman, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During the meeting, the Laser representatives summarized the arguments presented by the parties in the record of the above-referenced waiver proceeding. For the reasons stated by Laser and its predecessor-in-interest on the record in this proceeding, Laser reiterated that a grant of the requested waiver and the consequent freeing up of additional spectrum for wireless broadband use by Chicago consumers is in the public interest, and that over-the-air broadcast viewers in Chicago would not suffer harmful interference as a result.
