On May 7, 2014, Brendan Kasper, Vonage, and Glenn Richards, Executive Director of the Voice on the Net Coalition (VON), met with David Furth, Erika Olsen (by phone), Nicole McGinnis, David Siehl, Dana Zelman, Rasoul Safavian and Tim May, FCC Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, and William Richardson, FCC Office of General Counsel. During the meeting, VON discussed its comments filed in the above referenced proceedings concerning the capabilities of over-the-top providers to route text messages to 911, limiting any requirement to interconnected text providers, the jurisdiction of the FCC to impose a text-911 requirements and the applicability of liability limitations to OTT text providers if a requirement is imposed.
