Dear Mr. Genachowski,

In my opinion the Time Warner/Comcast cable merger is a bad idea. We need more competition in the cable and Internet marketplace, not less. Please consider these points when thinking about allowing Time Warner and Comcast to merge:

*The new Time Warner/Comcast company would control two-thirds of the nation's cable subscribers.

*They would also control nearly 40 percent of the U.S. broadband market.

*This merger would force content providers to pay more to get their programming broadcast on the new cable company, passing those price hikes on to customers.

*These two companies already rank at the bottom of the American Consumer Satisfaction Index based on surveys with over 70,000 consumers.

Please reject the Comcast/Time Warner Cable merger. Thank you for considering my concerns in your decision.
