Allowing Internet Service Providers to discriminate between different types of traffic will destroy the Internet. An "Internet Service" Provider's job is to provide Internet service - i.e. a connection to the Internet. An Internet Service Provider is NOT supposed to be and should not be in the business of choosing which content to provide to its customers. "The Internet" means "The WHOLE Internet". Please keep it that way.

Additionally, the idea of "fast lanes" does not actually mean that Internet Service Providers will offer faster connections for payment, because the standards of cabling and router capabilities are what determine the maximum speed of the Internet. Instead, it means that Internet Service Providers will impose arbitrary artificial caps on services, in effect creating a system of extra payment for "normal lanes" instead of "artificially slow lanes".
