In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, we hereby provide you with notice of an oral ex parte presentation in connection with the above-captioned proceedings. On May 9, 2014, the undersigned spoke by phone with Roger Sherman, Chief of the Wireless Bureau.

At his request, I clarified our position stated in our ex parte of May 7, 2014 as filed in these dockets. If given a choice between the current proposal and a proposal that did not differentiate between reserved and unreserved spectrum, U.S. Cellular would prefer a proposal that did not create reserved and unreserved categories. I further indicated that our first choice was still for the Commission to retain reserved spectrum but to apply a national market power analysis.
