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Allowing ISP's such as Verizon and Comcast to dictate the speeds with which certain services are delivered (based on double payment) would kill the innovation and creativity that has lead to the United States becoming a birthplace for many great software products and startup companies.

ISP's have historically been, and should continue to be, dumb pipes. Allowing them to charge companies to access to a "fast lane" will drive a stake through the heart of the internet as we know it today.
