I do not support the proposed merger between the Comcast and Time Warner Cable corporations. With the majority of Americans having two or fewer choices when it comes to broadband providers, the status quo of the industry is essentially federally-sanctioned monopolistic control. From my personal experience, Comcast is the only broadband provider in my region. Were there another viable broadband provider option in my region (i.e. Google Fiber), I would immediately terminate my Comcast service due to my extreme displeasure with their business practices.
