Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 19, 2014, Larry Coleman, Alan Katz, Paul Bradshaw, and Walt Tustin of Sunesys, LLC (“Sunesys”) and the undersigned met with Jon Wilkins of the Office of the Managing Director, Patrick Halley of the Wireline Competition Bureau, Trent Harkrader of the Wireline Competition Bureau, Michael Steffen, Director of Digital Learning, and Mark Walker of the Wireline Competition Bureau.

Sunesys discussed that in connection with the down payment, the Commission should use a significant portion of the funds on scalable build-out projects, or otherwise rural areas will be left behind. Sunesys believes it is important that any provider who receives funds under such projects should guarantee reasonable ongoing rates for many years. Sunesys also discussed that if multiple projects have similar merit otherwise, the externalities involved (such as benefitting consumers in rural areas as well) should be taken into account.
