

Dear FCC:

LMCC fails to mention that the majority of its constituents and incumbent 800 MHz SMR operators failed to apply for 800 MHz Expansion Band/Guard Band frequencies in the early round and now they claim they need more spectrum. They initially chose to not take advantage of the opportunity by not applying. Now they have suddenly decided to change their point of view to achieve an advantageous position. Permitting such incumbents a 6-month window, or any window whatsoever, in which to apply for EB/GB spectrum prior to applications being accepted by equally deserving new entrants is not consistent with FCC objectives for competition in the marketplace through the Telecommunications Act of 1996. I respectfully request that the Commission DENY the LMCC Petition.
