Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 23, 2014, on behalf of Neustar, Inc., I met with Clete Johnson, Chief Counsel of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau. During this conversation, I gave Mr. Johnson an overview of the architecture of number portability and outlined some of the security issues associated with that architecture. In particular, I discussed the Local Number Portability Enhanced Analytical Platform (LEAP) and its relationship to U.S. law enforcement activities. I also described the relationship between the number portability system and the Government Emergency Telecommunications Service (GETS) and Wireline Priority Service (WPS) emergency telephone services. Finally, I described the security consequences that could result from tightening links between number portability systems and carrier OSS/BSS systems.
