On May 28, 2014, Paula Boyd, Microsoft, Brendan Kasper, Vonage, and Glenn Richards, Executive Director of the Voice on the Net Coalition (VON), met with Gigi Sohn, Special Counsel for External Affairs and Daniel Alvarez, Legal Advisor, both from Chairman Wheeler's office; and Ms. Boyd and Mr. Richards met with Louis Peraetz, Legal Advisor for Commissioner Clyburn. During the meetings, VON discussed its comments filed in the above-referenced proceedings concerning the capabilities of over-the-top ("OTT") providers to route text messages to 911, VON's preference for routing texts to 911 through the end user's CMRS network, the difficulties of recovering any costs for implementing text-to-911 capabilities, limiting any requirement to two-way interconnected text providers, and the applicability of liability limitations to OTT text providers if a requirement is imposed.
