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When the cable giants start charging companies more for faster internet speeds, these companies will simply turn around and pass them onto consumers. What you're doing is allowing huge price increases to the customers of all the companies affected. In addition, you're penalizing new companies who don't have the customer base to absorb higher fees being charged by the ISP's. This is not good for American consumers in two ways. Having to pay higher costs and not being able to benefit from start ups that may be able to provide a wanted product if the internet playing field was level.
