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As a voter, educator, and Chemist, I'm extremely concerned about net neutrality, as it applies to my research, students, and their learning. Increasingly net neutrality is going away, as filter bubbles are being produced by major firms seeking to customize my access to the internet and its data. As a direct result my searches are no longer neutral allowing me to draw conclusions, but are shaped and customized without my being told, informed, or allowed to opt out. This is happening right now, and you don't see it unless you use several people in different locations, with diverse cultural, and education backgrounds. The results are very negative on learning, and the ability to critical think thru data, and its impacts on my students are visible, if we do not act now to restore net neutrality, this form of censorship in promotion of data harvesting, in favor of commerce will lead to a permanent dumbing down of the internet, so cat videos pop up in pure science research. We need to look closely at this filter bubble, and consider its implications to the growth of intelligence, education, and research for our children and college students.
