On May 27, 2014, the undersigned and other AT&T representatives met with Matt DelNero, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau, to discuss, among other matters, AT&T's ongoing outreach to consumers in the Carbon Hill, AL and West Delray Beach, FL wire centers regarding our proposal to conduct trials concerning the TDM-to-IP transition.¹ As a follow up to that meeting, and as further information concerning AT&T's outreach to consumers in the proposed trial areas, AT&T has planned the following community events over the next sixty days.

Also, in response to a recent inquiry from the staff AT&T indicated that it had not requested a formal decision on our proposal to conduct wire center trials and discussed the statement included in the Trial Update Letter that made clear we would not seek approval to withdraw TDM services in the trial wire centers any earlier than the second half of 2015.
