On June 11, 2014, the undersigned and Alexander Hoehn-Saric of Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter") met with Tim Stelzig, Deputy Division Chief of the Competition Policy Division, Rodney McDonald and Gregory Kwan of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the above-referenced Section 63.71 applications (the "Applications") requesting authority to discontinue certain interconnected VoIP services. Mr. Hoehn-Saric attended the meeting in person, while I attended the meeting via telephone.
