PARTIES’ JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the order of the Chief Administrative Law Judge dated June 9, 2014, Game Show Network, LLC (“GSN”) and Cablevision Systems Corp. (“Cablevision”) (collectively, the “parties”) submit the following joint status report in the above-captioned action.

A. Background

On April 17, 2014, the Presiding Judge issued an order concerning additional discovery sought by GSN that was informed by the D.C. Circuit panel’s decision in *Comcast Cable Communications v. FCC*.¹ Thereafter, on June 9, 2014 (the “June 9 Order”), the Presiding Judge ordered that the parties should proceed with discovery and “confer regarding a schedule for the disclosure of testifying expert or fact witnesses, any new or supplemental expert reports, and a timely deposition schedule.” The parties were then to report to the Presiding Judge on the status of those discussions by June 13, 2014.

B. Status Report of the Parties

In accordance with the June 9 Order, the parties have conferred on a potential schedule for the next phase of the case. Defendant Cablevision proposes the following schedule, to which GSN agrees. The parties thus respectfully request that the Presiding Judge adopt and order the parties to proceed in accordance with the following schedule:

July 15, 2014:	Supplemental Document Production Begins
September 12, 2014:	Supplemental Document Production Ends
October 20, 2014:	GSN identifies testifying expert and fact witnesses; GSN expert reports served
December 3, 2014:	Cablevision identifies testifying expert and fact witnesses; Cablevision expert reports served
December 3, 2014 – January 16, 2015:	Fact and expert deposition period

The parties believe that the foregoing schedule provides them with a reasonable time to meet and confer and complete the supplemental document production, staggers the dates for witness identification and any new expert reports, and thereafter provides a deposition period. GSN also states that such a schedule may enable the parties to benefit from further guidance from the Commission in response to the pending petition filed by Tennis Channel in the *Comcast* action.

The Enforcement Bureau has reviewed this proposed schedule and has informed the parties it has no objection.
