Re: *GN Docket No. 13-5, Technology Transitions; GN Docket No. 12-353, AT&T Petition to Launch a Proceeding Concerning the TDM-to-IP Transition*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Windstream Corporation herein submits an amended version of the chart it originally filed on May 20, 2014. The chart displays AT&T's rates available to Windstream for TDM special access services and comparable Ethernet products—both tariffed/publicly available and those specified in Windstream's commercial agreements with AT&T—as applicable to the Kings Point, Florida wire center.¹ Windstream is amending this chart to include port charges in the publicly available Ethernet rates. This amendment ensures the publicly available Ethernet rates address the same rate elements as commercially negotiated rates included in the attached. Port charges inadvertently were omitted from publicly available rates listed in the original filing.

Windstream seeks highly confidential treatment of portions of the attached chart pursuant to the Second Protective Order in the above-referenced proceedings.² These portions would allow a competitor to determine Windstream's specific special access input costs, which could substantially aid a competitor seeking to bid against Windstream for a particular customer.
