Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 12, 2014, John Goodman, Chief Legal Officer of Purple Communications, Inc. (“Purple”), Lydia Yomogida, Senior Manager Legal and Compliance Director for Purple, and Monica Desai, outside counsel to Purple, met with staff of the Consumer & Governmental Affairs Bureau of the FCC, including Robert Aldrich (Legal Advisor), Gregory Hlibock (Chief, Disability Rights Office), Elaine Gardner (Attorney Advisor, Disability Rights Office), and Eliot Greenwald (Attorney Advisor, Disability Rights Office). Mr. Goodman and Ms. Yomogida participated by phone, and Ms. Desai participated in person.

The meeting focused on Purple’s Emergency Request for Review seeking reversal of a decision by the Administrator of the Interstate Telecommunications Relay Service (“TRS”) Fund to withhold reimbursement for all Internet Protocol Captioned Telephone Service (“IP CTS”) minutes processed by Purple for November 2013.¹ In particular, the meeting focused on the details provided in Purple’s ex parte letter of June 2,² in which Purple emphasized that although it continues to urge the Commission to expeditiously reverse the Administrator’s decision, it has
