Support for NCTA’s Motion for Extension of Time

Telecommunications for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, Inc. (TDI), the National Association of the Deaf (NAD), the Hearing Loss Association of America (HLAA), the Association of Late-Deafened Adults (ALDA), the Cerebral Palsy and Deaf Organization (CPADO), the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Consumer Advocacy Network (DHHCAN), and Speech Communication Assistance by Telephone (SCT), collectively, “Consumer Groups,” and the Technology Access Program at Gallaudet University (TAP), respectfully support the June 10, 2014 motion of the National Cable and Telecommunications Association (NCTA) to extend the deadline for public comments and reply comments on portions of the Commission’s *Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the above-referenced proceeding by two weeks to July 9, 2014 and August 8, 2014.¹ We agree with NCTA that the proposed extension will provide additional time for stakeholders to provide more detailed and thorough information in response to the Commission’s inquiry, and believe that the proposed extension is sufficiently short that it will not prejudice the public interest. Accordingly, we support NCTA’s proposed extension.
