Consistent with NCTA's written comments,¹ we discussed issues pending in the above-captioned proceeding.

Specifically, we agreed that the Commission's rate rules and forms should be updated to reflect the deregulation of the cable programming service tier in 1999. We further discussed efforts to make adjustments to the rate rules to reduce unwarranted burdens on cable operators, local franchising authorities, and the Commission.
