Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Wednesday, June 11, 2014, the undersigned, on behalf of the Environmental Working Group ("EWG"), met with Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff for Commissioner Ajit Pai, to discuss the above-referenced proceedings. Specifically, we discussed EWG's interest in this issue from a public health perspective; the fact that Americans' exposure to cell-phone radiation is on the rise; studies concerning the potential health effects of cell-phone radiation, particularly for children; reasons why current radiation standards are inadequate and must be modernized to protect public health; and the importance of disclosing cell-phone radiation information to consumers.

In addition to discussing these points, EWG shared with Mr. Berry a copy of EWG's original comments on the proceedings (filed Sept. 3, 2013); subsequent reply comments (filed Nov. 18, 2013); EWG's 2009 report on the issue; a letter signed by twelve public interest groups calling for more stringent standards; and a petition spearheaded by EWG calling on the FCC to strengthen standards, which garnered more than 25,000 signatures. We have attached these materials hereto.
