Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Tuesday, June 17, 2014, Neustar, Inc. ("Neustar") representatives Becky Burr and Aaron Goldberger spoke with Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of General Counsel and Allan Manuel of the Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau ("Bureau") regarding the Bureau's request that Neustar redact from its bid documents in this proceeding certain information that the Bureau has determined could threaten national security if disclosed under the Commission's Second Level Protective Order released on June 9, 2014.¹

Also on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, Becky Burr and I separately spoke with Michele Ellison and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of General Counsel and Allan Manuel of the Bureau to discuss procedural and timing issues related to the Order. The Commission inquired about Neustar's ability to produce a set of documents reflecting the redactions sought by the Bureau. Neustar stated that it was working with Mr. Manuel and agreed that Mr. Manuel and Neustar representatives would meet in person on June 19, 2014, to confirm that Neustar's proposed redactions reflected the Bureau's request.

Neustar was informed that the Commission was considering issuing a first level protective order and a revised Appendix A for the Second Level Protective Order, but intended to make documents available under the existing Second Level Protective Order as soon as the above referenced redactions were implemented. Neustar expressed its continued objection to the Second Level Protective Order for all of the reasons previously expressed. Neustar urged the Commission to withdraw the flawed Order and work with Neustar, Ericsson, and the NAPM to create an appropriate set of protections for documents and information to ensure greater transparency in this proceeding. Neustar committed to work in good faith to this end, and stated

that comment deadlines for the Public Notice should be extended to reflect the date that documents become available for meaningful review by all affected stakeholders.

On Thursday, June 19, 2014, Aaron Goldberger and counsel Deborah Broderson met with Allan Manuel to confirm that Neustar's proposed redactions reflected the Bureau's request.
