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Net neutrality allows the citizens of the US access to all information at the same rate of speed/access. There are no rules that can be setup to allow for tiers that would ensure equal access to information. A tiered system would put larger companies at a greater advantage than smaller companies because larger ones would be able to pay the premiums that the providers set. It is basically limiting freedom of speech, access to information based on income/capital levels. What makes the internet so amazing is that it is unrestricted. Anyone can start a business online with an amazing product and have access to an enormous consumer base without fear their product's success will be negatively affected because they didn't select the higher performance tier. If the FCC ends Net Neutrality than it would not be promoting competition and innovation, but stifling it. If the FCC ended Net Neutrality, the agency would not be supporting the nation's economy by ensuring an appropriate competitive framework. Obviously, there is no competition when one stage is greater bandwidth than the other. If the FCC ends Net Neutrality then new technologies would not flourish because established technologies would have an increased advantage to beat competition.
