Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 24, 2014, Emmett O’Keefe, Elana Shapochnikov and Rich Neill of Cablevision Systems Corp., and the undersigned on behalf of Cablevision, met with Michelle Carey, Mary Beth Murphy, Steven Broecker, Maria Mullarkey, Diana Sokolow, Alison Neplok, Jeff Neumann, and Elana Reman of the Media Bureau, and Rosaline Crawford and Suzy Rosen Singleton of the Consumer & Governmental Affairs Bureau. Ms. Shapachnikov, Mr. Neill and Ms. Sokolow attended by telephone.

In the meeting, we discussed Cablevision’s efforts and progress towards applying the emergency information rules to linear programming delivered to mobile and other devices in the home over Cablevision’s Optimum Application (“App”). We explained that while viewers using the Cablevision App on a laptop or PC can access information transmitted over the secondary audio channel today, further development and software upgrades and testing are needed for distributing secondary audio on the Optimum App. Cablevision discussed its development process for this functionality, explained the timing associated with the necessary revisions to the Optimum App for it to be able to receive and pass through video description and emergency information over the secondary audio channel, and emphasized the need for the Commission to give it sufficient time to complete this complicated process.

Pursuant to section 1.1206(b) of the Commission’s rules, an electronic copy of this letter is being filed electronically with the Office of the Secretary and served electronically on the Commission participants in the meeting and the telephone call.
