On June 26, 2014, Joan Marsh met with John Leibovitz of the Wireless
Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

In the discussion, consistent with AT&T's reply comments dated June 23, 2014, Ms.
Marsh expressed AT&T's support for the Commission to (a) waive the "former defaulter
rule"; (b) clarify that post-auction payments will be due in early 2015 and not in 2014; c)
adjust the proposed minimum opening bid calculations by adopting a "population decile"-
based approach; and d) lowering the maximum bid increase increment.
