On June 30, 2014, Securus Technologies, Inc. (“Securus”), represented by Richard Smith, Chief Executive Officer, Dennis Reinhold, Vice President and General Counsel, and the undersigned counsel met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, her Legal Advisor, Rebekah Goodheart, and legal intern Wayne Connor.

Securus updated the Commissioner regarding ongoing market disruption caused by certain inmate calling service (“ICS”) providers continuing to pay site commissions out of interstate call revenue. Securus asked that the Commission issue guidance of some kind as to the legality of these payments.

The Commissioner informed Securus that it was selected as a panelist for the upcoming ICS Workshop to be held July 9, 2014, at FCC Headquarters.

Securus stated that it will provide a full cost study on July 17, 2014, in compliance with the Mandatory Data Collection.

Securus did not provide any handouts or materials during the meeting.
