Dear Madam Secretary Dortch,


The new rules will have a major effect on our company. We service many rural areas. It is not unusual for us to service a client 8 miles away in Ilwaco, WA from a tower in Chinook, WA; in fact we have one customer 35 miles away on remote San Juan Island that we service with a point-to-point link from Port Angeles, WA. To service these remote areas, we rely on long distance 5.8 GHz long links to connect our customers.

The lower power and smaller antenna restrictions imposed will reduce our coverage areas by limiting the distance that we can provide service to rural and remote customers.

Costs to add additional towers would exceed revenue. Thus, I would have to discontinue services to those customers and possibly close my business since most of my customer base is fed by 5.8 GHz links.

I request that the FCC reconsider this ruling and consider the damage to my business and the Wireless internet service provider industry.
