Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 7, 2014, Chas Eberle of the Telecommunications Access Policy Division spoke via telephone with Tracey Strobel, Jim Haprian, and Ron Stroup of the Cuyahoga County (OH) Public Library. The purpose of the call was to discuss wireless local area network (WLAN) costs for large public libraries. Ms. Strobel provided the attached budget summary for WLAN deployment in three newly constructed libraries. She explained that new construction WLAN costs are lower than upgrades for older library buildings. Ms. Strobel also noted that, according to her construction manager the cost for a 100 foot Cat 6 cable run to a wireless access point is \$600.
