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If the only way to keep ISP companies from taking advantage of the current unstable legal structure surrounding their services, than by all means, classify them a title II. They already have the limited monopolies than most other utilities hold within their respective regions, so why not regulate them under that same laws?

When the internet only required a phone jack and a modem, did we not rely on the phone companies to provide equal service to all, as limited as that seems from this age of millisecond uploads and fiber-optic technology? Why should ISPs be treated any differently?
