On July 14, 2014, Joan Marsh and the undersigned met with Erin McGrath, Legal Advisor to Commissioner O'Reilly regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

In the discussion, consistent with AT&T's reply comments dated June 23, 2014, AT&T expressed its support for the Commission to (a) adjust the proposed minimum opening bid calculations by adopting a "population decile"-based approach; (b) lower the maximum bid increase increment to twenty percent; (c) waive the "former defaulter rule"; (d) clarify that post-auction payments will be due in early 2015 and not in 2014; and (e) reject the proposal by T-Mobile and DISH to have separate auctions for the paired and unpaired AWS-3 bands.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, this notice is being filed in the above-referenced docket for inclusion in the public record.
