On July 15, 2014, Bob Quinn, Gary Phillips, Brent Olson, Philip Bowie and the undersigned of AT&T met with Daniel Alvarez, Legal Advisor to Chairman Wheeler for Wireline, Public Safety and Homeland Security. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Internet interconnection ecosystem. We explained how that ecosystem had developed without any regulation to handle all of the traffic exchanged on the global Internet and the many options available to edge providers to reach consumers and business. We also discussed the substantial cost implications of the exchange and carriage of Internet traffic that has become significantly out-of-balance. The attached presentation formed the basis of our discussion.
