MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

For the reasons herein, REC Networks (“REC”)¹ respectfully requests in advance a short extension of time for the comment period in the above captioned proceeding.

This proceeding has substantial impacts to Low Power FM (“LPFM”), FM translators and non-commercial educational (“NCE”) stations operating on non-reserved allotments.

The Grassroots Radio Conference (“GRC”) is being held this year in Ames, Iowa from Thursday, August 14 through Sunday, August 17, 2014².

Many of the stakeholders of the LPFM and community-based non-commercial FM radio services will be attending this Conference and will be traveling on the deadline date, August 18, 2014³.
