Please establish three new EAS Event Codes for Extreme Wind Warning (EWW), Storm Surge Watch (SSA) and Storm Surge Warning (SSW). At the present time, the EWW product is issued under the TOR event code. The EWW product is specifically for extreme winds in the eyewall of major hurricanes. It is important that the general public understands the difference between the two. Establishing a new code will allow the National Weather Service the ability to alert the general public of dangerous and destructive hurricane force winds in the eyewall at landfall.

Most deaths from hurricanes result from storm surge, not wind, not inland flooding, and not tornadoes. Establishing codes for Storm Surge Watches and Warnings will also allow the NWS to alert to the potential threat for this deadly phenomenon... SEPARATE from a blanket Hurricane Watch/Warning.
