On July 28, 2014, Jamie Barnett of Venable LLP and I, on behalf of Telcordia Technologies, Inc., d/b/a iconectiv ("Telcordia"), spoke with Allan Manuel and Kenneth Moran of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, and Michele Ellison, Joel Rabinovitz and Jim Bird of the Office of General Counsel. We discussed the fact that Neustar, in its comments, had redacted a number of arguments in their entirety, asserting national security concerns. We stated that based upon the headings, it did not appear that this was necessarily information specific to Neustar's systems, but was either of a more general nature or specific to Telcordia or Ericsson. In any event, we inquired as to what the process would be with respect to these redacted sections, to which we are unable to reply without seeing the arguments presented.
