On July 29, 2014, James Arden Barnett, Jr. and Frederick M. Joyce, of the law firm Venable LLP, an attorney representing TruePosition, Inc., a member of the Find Me 911 Coalition, met with Rear Admiral (ret.) David Simpson, Chief of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (“PSHSB”) of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”).

Mr. Barnett and Mr. Joyce discussed the strong record in this proceeding and the urgent need to adopt the FCC’s proposed rule to improve the E911 system. They informed Admiral Simpson that the public safety community needs the improvements offered by the FCC’s proposed standards. The meeting also covered a discussion of the rulemaking record and various comments that said that several technologies are available today or within the FCC’s proposed two-year timeframe that can meet the proposed indoor horizontal location standards. The men and women of the public safety and 911 communities strongly support the FCC’s adoption of its proposed rules to improve the E911 system now.
