I configure Quality of Service (QoS) hardware and software for companies so critical applications can have priority over non-critical traffic. The non-critical data is not just sent with a lower priority, it is dropped and has to be resent. If the network is congested, the critical traffic is given priority, and the non-critical data is dropped. This causes major issues with voice data, video data and time sensitive applications.

Please do not end net neutrality. The Internet, in the United States, would experience widespread issues and only Internet providers would benefit from it.
