In a Petition for Waiver filed Thursday, July 28, 2014, Sorenson Communications, Inc. and CaptionCall, LLC requested that the Federal Communications Commission permanently waive “the requirement that IP CTS [(Internet Protocol Captioned Telephone Service)] providers collect the last four digits of each subscriber’s social security number, where the subscriber does not have a social security number.”¹ Purple Communications, Inc. requests that if the Commission moves forward with granting the petition, the Commission apply any such waiver granted to Sorenson to all IP CTS providers.
