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I am poor and receive food stamps and lifeline telephone, etc. benefits. I can only afford very slow dial up internet. I have an old computer and can't afford a new one. I can't get off benefits and get a job working online because I can't afford a new computer or broadband or wifi. I can't save up much money because then I'll be disqualified for food stamps and benefits. I can't have over a certain amount of money in my bank account or I'll lose benefits. I am locked into poverty. I live in a small town, population 3,000. The next larger town is 8 miles east and population 9,000. At night on the long dark road between towns, there may be a street light at 3 mile intervals. I am a 62 year old woman, single, living alone. I am on the ballot for U.S. Congress, but I am denied participation in most political candidate debates because I am poor and have no campaign fund; and I am not a Democrat or a Republican. I have been on the ballot every two years for Governor since 2002 and Vermont Public Radio has never invited me to a general election candidate debate, despite the fact that they receive taxpayer dollars in huge amounts. I am blocked from many websites and I don't know why; I don't know if it is my slow computer, or if my URL is blocked. I can't "see" or participate in many websites with my old computer and dial up internet. I am running against U.S. Congressman Peter Welch for U.S. Congress, also, this year. He voted to lower food stamps 1% which means that out of 365 days a year, poor people like me will be even hungrier 3.65 days and could faint from hunger. I will be on two political candidate debates Aug. 13 and Aug. 15 on CCTV in Burlington, Vermont, public access t.v and it will be streamlined on the internet, but I won't be able to "see" it or hear it on my old computer with dial up internet.

candidate debates starting at 5:25 PM. I work on my political campaign website at the public library, but I am not allowed much computer time. Sometimes I drive 8 miles (each way) to Springfield, VT and get an hour or more on their computer. That costs me a gallon of gas. I have to count every penny. I feel like my e-mail is hacked into right now. I send an e-mail with political notes to myself, and it takes 4 minutes to reach my inbox. I suspect the government hates my campaign to legalize marijuana and blocks me from some websites. I suspect the Democrats and Republicans block me from some websites. I suspect that past court opponents block me from some websites because they are multi-national mega-corporations and they committed fraudulent concealment of material facts in court and may be afraid that even though the case is extremely old, that their behaviour was so incredibly corrupt that the courts may re-open. I have terrible pain when I am sitting at the computer at the public library, which has no comfortable orthopedically correct chair. I have a lump on the back of my neck. It hurts when I sit up at the computer. The primary care physician at Dartmouth Hitchcock in New Hampshire refused to x-ray where it hurts, he had the area above where it hurts x-rayed. The physical therapist hurt me and I refused to go back because there is no x-ray of where my neck hurts, and so it is not the physical therapists fault. The nurse said the doctor won't respond to my messages to him. I can't "see" the Dartmouth Hitchcock online patient portal because my computer is too slow and my dial up internet is too slow. The dial up internet service provider used to give me unlimited time for x number of dollars, and then suddenly changed the deal. I think I hurt my neck when the explosives package landed on my neck at work, the case I lost against the multiple mega-corporations. The explosive package included PETN plastic high explosives and lead azide and lead styphnate. It took me seven years in court to get a material safety data hazard sheet to prove their "trade secret" was not "harmless" chemicals. I just don't know if my computer problems are all because of an old computer and dial up internet, or the mega-corporations are forever trying to hurt me because Judge Thomas P. Greisa, U.S.D.C./SDNY published a court opinion telling what the trade secret chemicals were and he referred to them as "chemical weapons" and then dismissed my law suit.

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In the 2012 political campaign I was on the official election ballot in Vermont for Governor and for U.S. Senate. My website, which I have owned the domain, <http://criserson.com> for since about 2003, just disappeared entirely during the fall campaign season. Later I found out that the server has sold to another server, and it was quite an argument to get my domain back under my control. That is the problem with suing a mega-corporation in court, they can buy any business that you

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do business with and try to destroy you.
