To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this letter is to provide some additional information requested by FCC Staff. At the time that the application in this Docket was filed, there were pending Dockets related to separate transactions. Those transactions have very recently closed.

The result is that North-State Telephone Co. (North-State) has now acquired Home Telephone Company. Home Telephone Company is an incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) serving the Condon service area in north central Oregon. Home Telephone Company's Condon exchange is not adjacent to any of the exchanges of Pine Telephone System, Inc. Therefore, completion of the acquisition of Home Telephone Company has no effect on this Docket qualifying for streamlined treatment.

Further, Oregon Telephone Company, an affiliate of North-State, has a sixty percent interest in New Florence Telephone Company, an ILEC operating in the state of Missouri. New Florence Telephone Company has now completed the acquisition of three ILECs in Missouri. Those three ILECs are New London Telephone Company, Orchard Farm Telephone Company, and The Stoutland Telephone Company. All three of these companies are ILECs operating in the state of Missouri.



Finally, North-State owns one hundred percent of the stock of Skyline Telephone Company, an ILEC operating in the state of Washington. Both of the service areas of Skyline Telephone Company are in the northern part of the state of Washington. Therefore, there are no operations which are adjacent to one another from any standpoint.

Neither North-State nor Oregon Telephone Company have ownership interests in other telecommunications entities beyond those set forth in this Supplemental Letter or as disclosed in the Application in this Docket.
