
**ORDER**

Now before the Court are Plaintiff's Reply to Show Cause Order (Doc. 10) and Plaintiff's Motion for Dismissal of Justices, Congressman & Senators (Doc. 19). Within Doc. 10, Plaintiff seeks to voluntarily dismiss Separate Defendants Steven M. Colloton, Denny Chin, and Raymond W. Gruender. During a Show Cause Hearing on May 27, 2014, Plaintiff confirmed his intent and desire to dismiss said Defendants. In his Motion for Dismissal of Justices, Congressmen, and Senators, Plaintiff seeks to voluntarily dismiss all defendants, *except*: 5 Federal Communications Commissioners, FCC Chairman Tom Wheeler, Attorney General Eric Holder, Microsoft Corporation, and Google, Inc. Plaintiff's Motion for Dismissal was filed prior to any Answers being filed herein, and therefore the dismissals should be without prejudice. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A).

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED**, that Plaintiff's Motion to Dismiss (**Doc. 19**) is **GRANTED**. Separate Defendants, Steven M. Colloton, Denny Chin, Raymond W. Gruender, and Separate Defendants, Rep. Steve Womack, Rep. Tom Cotton, Sen. Mark Pryor, Hon. Jimm Larry Hendren, Diana E. Murphy, Pasco

M. Bowman II, Roger Leland Wollman, Kermit Edward Bye, Stephen Breyer, Antonin Scalia, Ruth B. Ginsberg, Anthony Kennedy, and Samuel Alito, are hereby **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
