I live in South Bexar County, 30 Minutes from the Heart of San Antonio, Tx, 7th largest city in the United States. I have no wired broadband internet service (ATT DSL or Time Warner Cable) available. Until November of 2011, I had to use either dial-up or an unreliable (and capped) slow 3g wireless service. At that time a small ISP company, Alamobroadband, began offering in our area a wireless service in the 5ghz band which was as fast as DSL and not user capped. I thought I had died and gone to heaven! Now the changes proposed in proceeding 13-49, threatens to destroy this service or make it cost prohibitive. I thought that that a goal of the FCC was to promote the availability of broadband in rural areas, but 13-49 will do exactly the opposite.

I encourage you not to implement these proposed rule changes and allow us to keep our current service.
