Dear Madam Secretary:

In a Petition for Waiver filed Thursday, July 28, 2014, Sorenson Communications, Inc. and CaptionCall, LLC (“Sorenson”) requested the Federal Communications Commission to permanently waive the requirement that Internet Protocol Captioned Telephone Service (“IP CTS”) providers collect the last four digits of each subscriber’s social security number, where the subscriber does not have a social security number.

InnoCaption, Inc. (formerly Miracom USA, Inc.) supports Sorenson’s Petition, and requests that if the Commission grants the petition, that any such waiver apply to all IP CTS providers.
