The pre-existing FCC 47CFR Section 15.247 rules are essential because...

- it enables Near-Line-Of-Sight coverage.

- it enables Long Range Coverage.

Long range coverage is essential so subscribers can reach the closest high capacity backbones.

Changing the rules of the 5.8Ghz band to be more restrictive is a giant step backwards, and will severely limit delivery of broadband to the underserved.
