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I want to express outrage at the lack of action by FCC in ensuring all deaf (including those with mild hearing loss) have equal access to communicate with each other. There are a boatload of platforms out there that enables us to call and communicate via video (videophones, Facetime-type applications, etc).

Yet the interoperability is poor. The only organization that can make this work across all platforms is FCC. There is no way the "invisible hand of free market" will make this work.

The onus is on you, FCC, to make this work and make us inclusive within the wider community the same way hearing people are currently experiencing.

But funny enough, if this is not fixed, the issues will spill over to the hearing community and they will find themselves struggling to connect with each other. Interoperability is the keyword here and it impacts EVERYONE, not just the deaf. We just happen to face it and suffer from it FIRST.
