**OPPOSITION TO REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Comcast Cable Communications, LLC, on behalf of its subsidiaries and affiliates (hereinafter "Comcast" or the "Company"), hereby submits this Opposition to the Request for Extension of Time submitted by Budd Broadcasting Co., Inc. ("Budd"), licensee of WFXU(TV) (Channel 48, Live Oak, Florida) ("WFXU" or "Station") in the above-referenced proceeding.

Although Comcast ordinarily would not object to a reasonable extension request, the Company believes that the request at issue is excessive. In this particular instance, the Station has already requested a 14 day extension of time beyond the 20 day period to which the Station is officially entitled.<sup>1</sup> As a courtesy, Comcast did not object to this first extension request, despite the fact that the Station offered no explanation as to why the additional response time was necessary. WFXU is now asking for an additional 57 days in which to respond.

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
<sup>1</sup> Comcast's Petition appeared on the Commission's official Public Notice on July 11, 2014. Under the Commission's rules, Oppositions were due on July 31, 2014, 20 days from the Public Notice date. See 47 C.F.R. § 76.7. On July 30, 2014, the Station submitted a Request for an additional 14 day, in which to file an Opposition in this case.

The Station is essentially seeking 91 days to prepare a response to a straight-forward 9 page Petition.<sup>2</sup> The requested response time would be more than 4 ½ times the amount provided for under the Commission's rules. Comcast believes that the request is unreasonable, particularly when WFXU has failed to identify any extraordinary circumstances or issues justifying this protracted schedule.<sup>3</sup>

Comcast respectfully requests that the Station's request be denied and that WFXU instead be afforded no more than an additional two week extension to August 28, 2014, to submit any Opposition in this proceeding. Comcast believes that this additional two week extension is more than fair.

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<sup>2</sup> Although there are additional exhibits attached to the Petition, the bulk of the exhibits are devoted to evidence regarding the location of the cable communities at issue, the distance between these communities and the Station's city of license, prior communications between the parties, and the Station's own signal coverage, none of which should require an extensive or prolonged review by the Station.

<sup>3</sup> The Station's vague reference to travel and vacation plans hardly justifies the lengthy delay requested in this case.


