Dear Madam Secretary:

On August 4, 2014, Messrs. Jeff Binder and Dave Fellows of Layer3 TV, Inc. (“Layer3 TV”) spoke on the phone with Jonathan Sallet, General Counsel, and Maria Kirby, Legal Advisor. The subject of the phone call was a briefing on Layer3 TV’s approach to the next generation of cable television. After Layer3 TV’s technical approach to cable television was described, the conversation turned to the inputs to the Layer3 TV system (the programming) and the outputs (usually the interconnection to service providers’ IP/DOCSIS infrastructures).

In the context of both of these latter topics (programming and IP/DOCSIS distribution), the subject of the proposed Comcast-Time Warner transaction was discussed. Layer3 TV requested that in the event the merger is to be approved, the FCC consider providing protections to competitors relating to programming access, peering and IP distribution. The construct of any specific protections were not discussed. Layer3 TV defers to a subsequent appropriate time any position it may have as to whether the merger should or should not be approved.
