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As a Time Warner subscriber I definitely do not think it is in the best interests of the consumer for the Comcast /Time Warner merger to take place. I already have few good choices for an internet and cable provider and have no say over how services are bundled and what I must purchase in a package. In order to get CNBC on my cable I must purchase many other stations that I never watch. Along with cable and internet I also have digital phone. A big problem is my bill does not separate out the specific charges. As a senior citizen I try and eliminate unnecessary purchases but that is impossible with the current Time Warner set up. I believe it will be worse for all consumers when the two very large providers merge and our choices, and the cost and service get worse. Competition is a good thing for consumers, merging the two large providers does not serve our needs or our best interests.
