The Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) licensee of noncommercial television station KLCS-TV, Los Angeles, California filed an Exemption Request pertaining to the Commission's Closed Captioning Rules. In Reply to an Opposition the Commission was advised that KLCS operated on Channel 41; that KLCS operates on three multicast channels; that total revenue (as revenue is defined by the Disability Rights Office) for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2014 totaled \$3,780,868; and that no channel provided or received \$3,000,000¹. Consequently, pursuant to Section 79.1(d)(12) of the Commission's rules, as amended, LAUSD/KLCS hereby withdraws its Exemption Request.
