Explanation of Appeal

We are writing to appeal the denial of a request to correct a 471 funding commitment.


An appeal was sent to the SLD on August 18 for FRN 2467413. We received a letter dated 8/21/14 stating that the appeal was filed more than 60 days after the FCDL therefore USAC could not process it. The FRN was submitted online with a monthly recurring cost of \$75 and a non-recurring cost of \$1,960 for a total annual Pre-Discount cost of \$2,860. The FRN was approved as submitted on 2/26/14. We have just discovered that a clerical was made in the submission of this FRN and the monthly recurring amount submitted was incorrect. The FRN was for (21) new POTS lines and the total price for these from the bid was \$464.73 per month. We meant to input a monthly amount of \$464.73 using the bid response pricing from the vendor as backup documentation. Per the Naperville order, we feel this falls under the ministerial and clerical error section and should be corrected accordingly.

Based on this information we ask that a revised FCDL be issued for this FRN to adjust the monthly amount to \$464.73 per month so that the School District can receive the proper needed funding for this service. We believe this was a ministerial and clerical error that the incorrect amount was submitted and was not corrected during the RAL period.

I have attached copies of the appeal letter to USAC, the USAC appeal denial letter, and relevant bid response pages from the vendor.
